



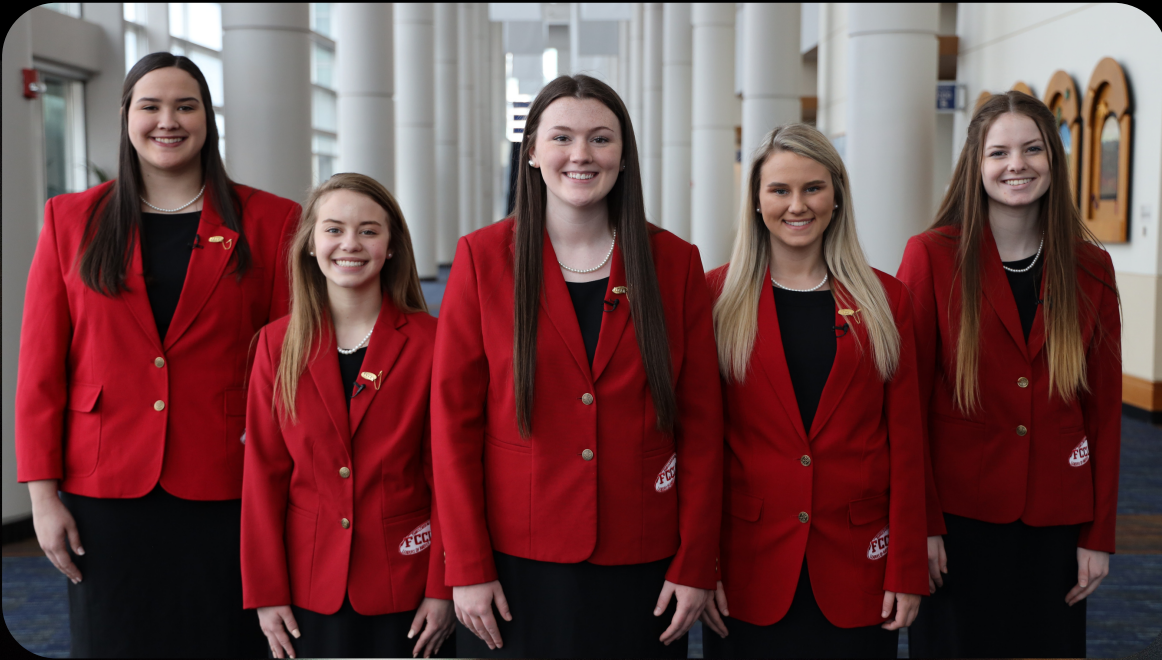

## GUIDELINES

Voting Delegates play a vital role in deciding the future of Tennessee FCCLA. Please review this information carefully and be ready to decide who will best serve Tennessee FCCLA on the next Executive Council. As you go through the Voting Delegate information-be sure to pay close attention to candidate speeches, resumes, and the recorded fishbowl question before you cast your vote. The future leaders of Tennessee FCCLA should show exemplary communication skills, dedication to TN FCCLA, and a true passion for servant leadership. Be aware of the responsibility you have assumed as an official voting delegate. You are the voice for your chapter and should take the responsibility of electing Tennessee FCCLA's next team of leaders seriously.

All Voting Delegates should have access to the Virtual Platform to review the Business Session that will include the candidate speeches and the Meet the Candidates Session which will include one fishbowl question per candidate. An email providing you with the Voting Link will be sent to you prior to the State Leadership Conference. You will have 24 hours to cast your vote once the Business Session goes live. You may only cast your vote once and will be allowed to choose only one slated individual for each Executive Council position.
