



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Tennessee Association of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America awards scholarships to outstanding Family, Career and Community Leaders of America seniors.

- Seniors who plan to major in Family and Consumer Sciences Education as freshmen in Tennessee colleges or universities are preferred.
- Two scholarships of \$300 each, the Margaret Browder Scholarship and the Elizabeth Chapman Scholarship, are awarded at the annual FCCLA State Leadership Conference.
- Payments for these scholarships are made directly to the college or university where the scholarship recipients are enrolled during the fall quarter or semester of their freshman year.

Purposes of the Scholarship:

- To further interest in the Family and Consumer Sciences Education profession.
- To encourage members to prepare for a career in Family and Consumer Sciences Education.
- To promote a stronger Family, Career and Community Leaders of America program by encouraging recipients to become effective chapter advisers.
- To provide financial assistance to members having the qualifications herein set forth.

Qualifications of Scholarship Applicants:

- Accepted for enrollment in Tennessee community college or university.
- Be an active member of an affiliated chapter of the Tennessee Association of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America for at least three years.
- Preferred but not required: majoring in Family and Consumer Sciences Education in an accredited four year college or university in Tennessee which offers Family and Consumer Sciences Education.
- Be a current senior and graduate from a senior high school in Tennessee with an overall grade average of "C" or above.
- Show evidence of having assumed leadership responsibility within the local chapter, such as serving as an officer or chairperson of a major committee.
- Accurately complete the scholarship application form and return the completed application form with requested information to the state office by the January 30, 2018 deadline.

Attach the following information to the application form:

- Reasons for choosing family and consumer sciences as a major
- Justification of financial need
- Recent photograph
- An official transcript of the applicant's high school record
- Letters of recommendation from the following:
 - Local adviser
 - High school principal
 - Parent/guardian with comment on the benefits of the human services/education and training program to the applicant and his/her family
 - One community leader with whom you have actively worked on an FCCLA project
 - The executive council of your local chapter
 - Career and technical education director and/or director of schools
